<b>DRUG:</b>	<b>MICONAZOLE</b>
<b>PRESENTATION:</b>	Cream: 2% (20mg/g) Ointment: Miconazole 2.5mg/g and (Daktazin, Resolve®) Zinc oxide 150mg/g Oral Gel: 20mg/mL
<b>ACTION &amp; INDICATION:</b>	Antifungal agent for the treatment of topical and oral fungal infections
<b>DOSE:</b>	<b>Oral Gel:</b> Apply approximately ONE centimeter of gel four times a day to mouth. Rub around gums and inside of mouth using a cotton bud or finger. Do not use a spoon to administer gel. <b>Cream:</b> Apply twice daily <b>Ointment:</b> Apply at each nappy change for at least seven days.
<b>COMMENTS:</b>	Avoid contact with the eyes.
