| Presentation | Tablet: 200mg Combination tablet: 200mg Mifepristone/200microg Misoprostol |
| Storage | Store at room temperature, below 25°C |
| Dose | Refer to relevant KEMH Clinical Guidelines for appropriate dose regimes (links below) |
| Administration | <u>Oral</u> Take on an empty stomach - should not be taken within 2 hours of a meal. |
| Pregnancy | 1st Trimester: Contraindicated 2nd Trimester: Contraindicated 3rd Trimester: Contraindicated |
| Breastfeeding | Considered safe to use |
