Presentation	Tablet: 200mg Combination tablet: 200mg Mifepristone / 200microg Misoprostol
Dose	Refer to relevant KEMH Clinical Guidelines for appropriate dose regimes (links below)
Administration	Oral Do not take within TWO hours of a meal
Pregnancy	1st Trimester: Contraindicated 2nd Trimester: Contraindicated 3rd Trimester: Contraindicated
Breastfeeding	Considered safe to use
