Dose	Prophylaxis for post-partum haemorrhage			
	IM:			
	200-500microg after complete delivery of the placenta			
	Postpartum haemorrhage

	NB: this route is more likely to cause hypertension, nausea and vomiting			
	Management of Uterine Tone at Caesarean Birth IM:			
	200-500microg			
	IV:			
	250microg			
	NB: this route is more likely to cause hypertension, nausea and vomiting			
Administration	IV Injection			
	<i>Dilution</i> : Dilute to 5mL with sodium chloride 0.9%			
	Administration: Inject slowly over at least 1 minute			
	IM Injection			
	Suitable			

Pregnancy	1 st Trimester: Contraindicated			
	2 nd Trimester: Contraindicated			
	3 rd Trimester: Contraindicated			
Breastfeeding	Considered safe to use			
Monitoring	Blood Pressure, Dyspnoea, Chest pain, Palpitations, headache
