**HIGH RISK Medication** 

<b>Presentation</b>	Vial: 80mg/2mL
<b>Dose</b>	As per <a href="#">Gentamicin Dosing and Monitoring</a>
<b>Administration</b>	<b><u>IV Infusion</u></b> <i>Dilution:</i> Dilute to 50 - 200mL NaCl 0.9% or Glucose 5% <i>Administration:</i> Infuse over 20 to 30 minutes
<b>Pregnancy</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> Trimester: Monitoring required 2 <sup>nd</sup> Trimester: Monitoring required 3 <sup>rd</sup> Trimester: Monitoring required
<b>Breastfeeding</b>	Considered safe to use
<b>Monitoring</b>	Refer to <a href="#">Gentamicin Dosing and Monitoring</a>
