# BREASTFEEDING BASICS AND BEYOND

## Breastfeeding Matters

- A series of 5 half-day study days (4 hours) F2F - Book sessions individually
- Covers a variety of topics:
  - May 5 Session 1** - benefits of BF, BFHI, antenatal screening, discussing feeding choices
  - May 19 Session 2** - physiology, skin to skin, expressing
  - June 2 Session 3** - impact of early formula, P & A, BF variances, alternative feeding
  - June 16 Session 4** - support after discharge, BF older child, Transition back to full BF, tandem feeding
  - June 30 Session 5** - BF multiples, BF after infant loss, mastitis, supporting decline medical recommendations

## Breastfeeding Policy

- Full day study day (8 hours - pre-reading and F2F)
- BFHI Group 1
- Mandatory training requirement for newly employed WNHS staff who will be working with breastfeeding mothers and their babies and is a BFHI requirement
- Also recommended for continuing staff to communicate any changes to breastfeeding policy
