## Addendum CTG review during Covid -19

This document is to be used in conjunction with the "<u>Cardiotocography(CTG) Monitoring</u> <u>Mandatory education requirements for midwives and medical practitioners</u>" procedure document.

- FSEP face to face sessions have been suspended during Covid-19.
- This describes the changes to antentatal CTG review (page 5 of procedure document) at WNHS until further notice.
- There are no changes to intrapartum CTG review requirements.

## Categories equivalent to level 2 or 3 FSEP practitioner status during Covid-19

- 1. Attended and passed FSEP (≥66%) with the last 3 years (including course attended externally to KEMH)
- 2. Allocated FSEP (March, June, September 2020 face to face session unavailable) receive OFSEP certifcate and achieve KEMH MCQ score of ≥75%
- 3. FSEP attended external to KEMH and expired in 2020 –receive OFSEP certifcate and achieve KEMH MCQ score of ≥75%
- 4. Successfully completed AFA in the last 5 years
- 5. AFA expiry in 2020, not allocated FSEP 2020 receive OFSEP certifcate and achieve KEMH MCQ score of ≥75%

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
